About the VITT: VITT is a virtual platform providing online support and tools for teams working in European projects to improve intercultural communication and to build on their cultural diversity for an effective implementation of their projects. It consists mainly of three tools: the Kick-off Tool (assessing team diversity and building culturally sensitive common ground rules), the Monitoring Tool (monitoring project implementation from several perspectives connected with intercultural communication) and the Evaluation Tool (evaluating the way team diversity was managed during the project).
